

ANDREW N NICOLAIDES MS, FRCS, FRCSE, PhD (Hon)

Professor Andrew Nicolaides was the Professor of Vascular Surgery at the Imperial College School of Medicine (St Mary's Hospital) and Consultant Vascular Surgeon at St Mary's Hospital from 1983–2000 and Medical Director of the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics from 2001-2004. He is now Professor of Surgery at St George's University of London / University of Nicosia Medical School, Nicosia, Cyprus. His research group is known internationally in several areas which include noninvasive vascular screening and diagnostic investigation, early detection and prevention of cardiovascular and venous disease. His research is now directed towards the genetic risk factors for cardiovascular disease, identification of individuals at risk and the development of effective methods of prevention, especially stroke. He is Past-President of the International Union of Angiology and Past-President of the Section of Measurement in Medicine of the Royal Society of Medicine. He is co-author of over 500 original papers and editor of 14 books.
