

Dear friends of Phlebology!

On behalf of the German Society for Phlebology, I have the honour to invite you to the centre of Germany for the 64th Annual Conference of the German Society for Phlebology from September 29th to October 1st, 2022, which will be held in presence and online to reach every corner of the world.

Venous insufficiency is a disease with a highest prevalence and serious consequences such as leg ulcer are of great economic relevance for the solidarity system. The same applies to chronic lymphedema and deep vein thrombosis and its sequelae, which often require long-term therapy. There are many therapeutic approaches from

- wait and see
- conservative therapy in form of
 - medication
 - physiotherapy
 - lifestyle corrections
 - compression or for all of the chronic diseases we treat.
- "invasive" therapy with venous sparing or eradication strategies, using the following techniques:
 - sclerotherapy
 - surgery
 - endoluminal heat or chemical treatment – stenting

How to choose the right one from the options for these patients? According to the socio-cultural environment, the skills of the doctor and the wishes of the patients? Choosing wisely means "Make smart decisions together".

In addition to the main lectures, ultrasound courses for the superficial and deep leg veins, workshops on sclerotherapy and endoluminal treatment, as well as surgical techniques are offered. There will be joint meetings with German Vascular Surgery Societies, as well as with the French, the Polish, the Australian and the Egyptian Societies of Phlebology.

Important international and national faculty is a guarantee for high level education and science sessions, as well as good discussions. The congress will be translated into English simultaneously on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Two rooms are also streamed online for an international audience.

To make a participation affordable for everyone interested, we allocated low prices, specially for early bird registration (ending July 27th, 2022) for 190€ in the streaming segment for all 3 days, 90€ for non medical health care professionals. The experience of 2 COVID years has shown us, that there is a huge international interest on didactic conferences – we took this into consideration when planning the english spoken sessions in a mix of didactic information and up to date science.

The Hanover Congress Centre is located in the middle of the city and still in the countryside, at the zoo and near interesting places where the exchange can continue in the evenings. Logistically, Hanover is a well-known and proven trade fair city with an airport and a wide railway connection. Ancient places, modern buildings, parks invite you to stay and enjoy.
